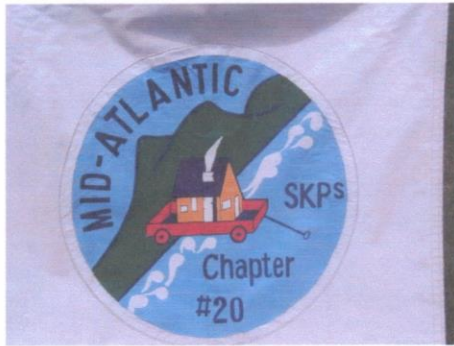


Adopted, July 17, 2004

**Standing Rules
For
Mid-Atlantic Chapter 20 Escapees**

1. In order to provide continuity, terms of office of the elected officers will be staggered by having the president and secretary elected in odd numbered years, and the vice president and treasurer in the even-numbered years.
2. The treasury shall be audited at each election or re-election of the treasurer.
3. The duties of the president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer shall be as specified in the various chapter officers' handbooks in effect at the time of passage of this article for the respective positions.
4. One rally shall be held during May and one in July.
5. No rally shall be scheduled to conflict with any National Escapee function, such as the Escapade, if such function is within 1,200 air miles.
6. The chapter letter editor shall be appointed by the president. The editor shall perform duties as specified in the editor's handbook provided by Escapees, Inc.
7. A chapter letter shall be published and mailed to each paid-up chapter member for no fewer than four times per year. They will sent shortly after each rally, and one in the early spring.
8. The name of the chapter letter shall be MID Atlantic Newsletter.
9. An historian, appointed by the president, shall maintain an album, and such other records as appropriate.
10. A wagon master, appointed by the vice president, shall perform the tasks listed in the handbook.
11. A membership chairperson shall be appointed by the vice president. The membership chairperson shall perform the tasks listed in the handbook.

12. No smoking shall be permitted inside any room where a chapter function is held if such function is open to all members.
13. The president shall make all reasonable efforts to have a chapter member attend each Escapade as a representative of the chapter. The officers are encouraged to volunteer for this position.
14. The treasurer shall reimburse the Escapade representative for the Escapade registration fee if the chapter has voted to do so.
15. The treasurer shall reimburse the actual cost of favors and refreshments for distribution by representatives at the Escapade, except that this may not exceed \$50 per event as voted on by the chapter.
16. The following shall be the only official logo of this chapter. It may be used on an item offered for resale only with prior approval of two elected officers.



17. The host has the authority to require reservations with appropriate camping fee plus \$5 rally fee due not later than 2 weeks before the rally. This fee shall be paid to the rally hosts or campground depending on campground regulations. If paying the campground directly, notice and rally fee must be given to the rally hosts.
18. Hosts are authorized to increase the rally fee up to \$10 if necessary.
