Technology Corner Sending Pictures

I know that many of us often get frustrated when trying to send someone some digital pictures. A very simple way to manage, share, edit and save pictures is with the **FREE** program from Google, called **Picasa**. It can be downloaded directly from http://picasa.google.com/. If you would like some help understanding the program you can view several tutorials from http://www.geeksontour.com/. This is a valuable website built for RV travelers. There are several free videos that you can watch explaining Picasa, Google Earth and much more. If you want to view all of the videos there is a \$39 joining fee, which is well worth the money. Also, if you have a chance to attend any of their seminars, they come very highly recommended.

The one thing I learned from a recent video on Picasa, is that if you have some pictures that are a higher resolution, and you want to send them to someone by e-mail, it can be difficult. Picasa's e-mail option will **automatically resize and attach your pictures for you!** If you have some time to work with the program and videos, I am sure you will be pleased with how easy it is to use. You can also upload your photos to a web album for all of your family and friends to share. This is easier than trying to send many pictures by email. I used it all last winter and it allowed me to keep family and friends updated on our travels.
